#### **GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:**

This product tanker is an **improved version of the standard "Broz Tito" type tanker**, built in shipyards in Split, Rijeka and Uljanik, Yugoslavia for the Soviet merchant navy and delivered to various shipping companies in the Black Sea and in the Far East (Nakhodka), all about 24 units. (http://www.swiss-ships.ch/schiffe-ausland/abc/g-ordzhonikidze\_9HLG4/fr\_g-ordzhonikidze\_9HLG4.htm)

1988:This vessel was **built under the name "GRIGORIY ORDZHONIKIDZE**" by Brodogradiliste "Split", Split under the hull No. 355 for the Georgian Shipping Company of Batumi, Soviet Republic of Georgia. The keel was laid on 12.06.1987, the launching was on 19.12.1987 and the delivery to her owners was on 11.11.1988, IMO / Lloyd's Register No: 8517047, official No: M-43038, call sign: UBKY. 1994: this vessel and her sister vessels "AKADEMIK VEKUA", "AKADEMIK UZNADZE" and "ILYA CHAVCHVADZE" were **transferred to Anglo-Georgian Shipping Company Ltd.**, London and flagged out to the Maltese registry. The technical management was allocated to ABC Maritime AG in Nyon. The "GRIGORIY ORDZHONIKIDZE" was taken over on 18.07.1994 and was renamed "G. ORDZHONIKIDZE". She was registered in Valletta, owners: Zonda Shipping Company Ltd., Valletta, official No: 4208, call sign: 9HLG4. 1998 the technical management was transferred to Anglo Eastern Management Ltd. U.K (Denholm), Glasgow and later in July 1999 it was again transferred to Columbia Shipmanagement Ltd., Limassol, Cyprus.

2000 the vessel was **sold to Nino Shipping Co., Ltd.,** Majuro, Marshall Islands and renamed "NINO" (official No: 1474, call sign: V7CK2). 2001 the management was given to Columbia Shipmanagement (Netherlands) B.V., Spijkenisse.

On 17.07.2002, when on passage with a cargo of 7700 metric tons of gas oil from Durban to Mossel Bay, the "NINO" went aground during heavy weather on a sandbank about 70 miles Northeast of East London. A South African Airforce helicopter took off 16 persons of a total crew complement of 27 and the salvage tug "Wolraad Woltemade" arrived on the scene. After most of her cargo was discharged, the tanker was refloated on 31.07.2002 with the assistance of the salvage tug "Wolraad Woltemade". Anchored at Algoa Bay on 05.08.2002 and following an inspection she was towed to Durban. After repairs the vessel was reported to go on service again on 06.02.2003.
