GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:

The 1992 built, 96,828 dwt **STENA CONCERT**, a double hull ship with no centreline bulkhead, sold for US\$21m.

The Maltese-flag, 96,828-dwt tanker (built 1992) with the unfortunate name **TSUNAMI** appeared to suffer a loss of control and hit the ST Services terminal at Westwego, Louisiana, about 100 miles up the river. It had loaded in Venezuela for discharge at International-Matex Tank Terminals' site at St Rose, north of New Orleans. The S.T. Services pier in Westwego, La., suffered extensive damage after the tanker **TSUNAMI** ran into it. The collision at 1100 local time left a three-foot gash in the double-hull tanker's outer shell but above the waterline, leaving the cargo of 85,000 tonnes of crude and bunkers intact. The tanker's managers, Cardiff Marine of Piraeus, part of the Economou group, said the ship was under pilotage at the time.

BW Offshore officially named **BW PIONEER** at Keppel Shipyard in Singapore on 26 October. **BW PIONEER** will be the first FPSO for the hurricane-prone US Gulf of Mexico, and is on track to arrive in US waters in January 2010 and begin operations in the first half of 2010. The vessel is on a five-year fixed lease with three one-year extension options for Petrobras America.
