GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:

UK Falmouth Coastguard received Nov, 20 call from heavy lift CEC COWBRIDGE via satellite telephone 250 miles off coast of Brazil, to inform proceeding to assistance of Liberian Flagged, Dutch chemical **STOLT TENACITY** -- had suffered engine room fire -- vessel had to activate CO2 system, causing total loss of engine power --had auxiliary back up systems, but cabling burnt out to emergency generator. No injuries to crew. CEC Cowbridge called Falmouth Coastguard in UK because they were unable to raise Brazilian Rescue Authorities. Fortunately a Watch Officer at Falmouth Coastguard is fluent Spanish speaker & able to communicate with crews & Brazilian Authorities. (Fri. Nov. 29 2002) - Report by Cargo Letter
