1996: The 165,000-dwt **THALASSINI AXIA has reportedly been fixed by Cetrappa of France** for USD 15,250-15,500 per day for 12 months. **The charter will start in July, when the vessel is delivered from China Shipbuilding Corp in Taiwan.**

2000: **BHP of Australia has reportedly extended the charter of the 164,000-dwt bulk carrier THALASSINI AXIA (built 1996) from NS Lemos of Greece.** The vessel has been taken for another two years from March and is set to fetch \$16,500 per day. Brokers say the bulk carrier has been earning some \$15,000 per day for the last two years on its BHP charter.
