**Developed a list to port of more than 35° in a severe gale 6/1/2005** when in position 56.28N, 07.24W. The list subsequently increased to over 50 and some of the deck cargo was jettisoned. The Barra lifeboat was launched and she was escorted into Castlebay. She was on passage from Riga for Liverpool with timber.
