### **GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:**

On February 10, Toyofuji inaugurated the car-carrier vessel, TRANS FUTURE 6, for use on its Oceania routes.

The new vessel was built in response to Toyofuji's policies of slimming down its fleet, increasing vessel size, minimizing costs and maximizing shipments. It is one of the largest car-carrier vessels in the world.

In addition to car shipments, Toyofuji's Oceania routes are used to ship wooden products, motorboats and other cargo from New Zealand to Japan. Toyofuji will continue to provide even better services on its Oceania routes, which have been strengthened by the inauguration of the TRANS FUTURE 6.

The largest vehicle carriers now servicing New Zealand ports are Trans Future 5 (60,414 gross tonnage, built 2005), and her sister ships **TRANS FUTURE 6** and Trans Future 7 (both 60, 401 gross tonnage, built 2006). They are operated by Toyofuji Shipping Co. Ltd., Aichi, Japan, fly the Panamanian flag, and are 200 metres length overall. All were built by Mitsubishi Heavy Industries Ltd. at Nagasaki, Japan.
