Lugano – Nova Marine Carriers, the joint venture participated by Romeo and Duferco, goes ship-hunting again. Monte di Procida-native shipowner, who set up in Lugano 9 years ago, negotiated the purchase of 5 second-hand units, hence managing overall 103 ships.

In essence, four 8,000 dwt minibulkers of German Hartmann (the UBC Moin, built in 2009, UBC Mariel, 2009, UBC Manzanillo, 2011 and UBC Maracaibo, 2012), as well as the 14,000 dwt Arklow Wave, built in Japan in 2004, already renamed NACC Toronto, which joined the fleet of NACC – Algoma newco

The 4 minibulkers were sold by UBC United Bulk Carriers, headquartered in Wayne, Pennsylvania, controlled by Germany-based Hartmann (holding branches in Manila, Gdynia, Limassol and Singapore), founded in 2001 by managers and shareholders who gained former experience in this field and
