ON January 1 this year Uniglory Marine Corporation added the Iranian port of Bandar Abbas to its growing list of Middle East destinations. Five of the carrier's 1,164-TEU vessels will provide a weekly link between Bandar Abbas and leading Asian ports including Singapore, Hong Kong and Kaohsiung. Uniglory's APG Service now has a port rotation of Kaohsiung, Taichung, Hong Kong, Singapore, Colombo, Dubai, Dammam, Bandar Abbas, Penang, Port Klang, Johor and Kaohsiung. The first Uniglory vessel, the **UNI-ASPIRE**, called at Bandar Abbas on January 6.
