GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:

The world's largest container ship, **XIN LOS ANGELES**, has been delivered by Samsung Heavy Industries Co Ltd (SHI) to Lloyd's Register class. The ship is owned by China Shipping Container Lines (CSCL) and is operated by China International Shipmanagement Company Ltd, a joint venture between CSCL and V.Ships. The ship is 9,600 teu and is the first in a series of eight being built by SHI. The ship will trade from China to Europe initially and will eventually also trade to the US.

XIN LOS ANGELES can carry a maximum of 18 rows of containers by eight tiers on the weather deck and 16 rows by 10 tiers in the holds.

THE XIN LOS ANGELES, the world's largest container ship, arrived early Wednesday (June 28) in Korea's port city of Busan, port officials said. The 9,600-TEU-class vessel made the port call at Gamman Pier around 4:00 a.m. after thick fog delayed its arrival for 11 hours in waters off Busan. After loading 2,350 TEUs of cargo, the Xin Los Angeles is scheduled to head for China's eastern port of Ningbo later in the day.

The Port of Felixstowe has welcomed the inaugural call of the world's largest container ship, the CSCL **XIN LOS ANGELES**, operated by China Shipping Container Lines (CSCL) of Shanghai. The giant container ship, which is capable of carrying 9,560 TEU, has the highest declared capacity of any container ship currently in operation, and has a gross tonnage of 106,700, a length of 337m and a breadth of 45.6m.
