Foremost puts capesize trio up for sale







US dry bulk shipping company Foremost Group has put three capesize bulkers up for sale.

According to broking sources, the three bulkers are the 2010-built 178,000 dwt Ping May and 2011-built 176,000 dwt Guo May and Zhong May.

According to MSI, the fair market value for the Ping May is \$29m, Guo May \$31.2m and Zhong May \$28.9m.



Foremost sells off two older capes



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Foremost has 19 ships in the two largest bulker segments, averaging about six years, according to VesselsValue data. Currently, the oldest ship, *Zhong May*, was delivered in January 2011 and is also reported as sold along with the two SWS-built sister capes. The company's other remaining 2011-built ship is a newcastlemax *Lan May* some brokers list as snapped up by Winning Shipping, together with 2012-built *Qing May*. Assuming all of these transactions are closed, Foremost's oldest tonnage would be on its way out. In July last year, Foremost also offloaded the 2010-built cape *Bao May*, now known as Michalis Jr for about \$25.5m.
