**Djibouting Shipping launches first container service**

Djibouti Shipping Company, a new carrier based in Djibouti, in mid-July launched its first container service.

The new service is ensured with the 1,118 teu AFRICA SUN, a geared 1,118 teu ship of the 'CV 1100' type. Djibouti Shipping acquired the 2006-built vessel, the former ASIAN SUN, from German interests in March.

The Djibouti Shipping Company, the new vessel and the new container service are aimed at promoting Djibouti's shipping activities and provide 'importers and exporters in the East African region with (...) a reliable transport solution with no interruption'. The AFRICA SUN was hence placed under the Djibouti flag.

The vessel was officially presented to the public on 19 July by Ismail Omar Guelleh, President of the Republic of Djibouti.

The AFRICA SUN will cater for Djibouti's import and export traffic, and for feeder volumes.

The vessel was dry-docked in Turkey and in June she performed a first commercial trip under DSC management with cargo loaded at Mersin, for Djibouti.
