GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:

The Greek shipping firm Tsakos said last month that one of its vessels, the million-barrel tanker Argosea, loaded at Iraq's Khor al-Amaya terminal on the Persian Gulf and sailed past U.S. and Canadian warships to Aqaba, where the oil was transferred to smaller tankers that headed in different directions. The Khor al-Amaya terminal is not authorized by the United Nations to export oil. Tsakos general manager Harry Hajimichael said his firm had not been aware that it violated international sanctions. The company is in the midst of an internal investigation.
