MPC Container Ships buys 14 ships of 1,300-2,800 teu

MPC Container Ships ASA, an Oslo-based containership investment vehicle, announced the acquisition of 14 container vessels of 1,300 to 2,800 teu for a total purchase price of \$139.5 M. The ships are acquired from German interests and are managed by Hamburg-based Ahrenkiel Steamship.

MPC Container Ships was formed in April 2017 by German company MPC Capital AG with a view to building up a fleet of 1,000 - 3,000 teu container vessels for the charter market.

MPC Container Ships acquires 14 more ships for a total price of \$139.5M. All 14 units are expected to be transferred by the end of March 2018.
