GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:

Ships with names including the prefix ARKTIS were owned by Elite Shipping A/S, Denmark. During early 1999, Elite Shipping found itself in financial trouble. Eventually a solution to the problems was achieved by a merger with the Clipper Group. A new company, Clipper Elite Carriers, was set up and began trading on 1st July 1999. All 65 vessels in the fleet are to be renamed with CEC prefixes. The first to be renamed was ARKTIS PIONEER which became CEC PIONEER. The rest of the fleet will be similarly renamed.
