An information vacuum is surrounding reports that Kollakis-controlled Chartworld of Greece has sold its four Aframax tankers at very advantageous prices. Brokers suggest the 112,700-dwt Aegean Spirit, Chios Spirit, Ionian Spirit and Oinoussian Spirit (all built 2002) have gone to Libyan interests, possibly General National Maritime

In tankers, Intermodal, Lorentzen & Stemoco and Anchor Shipbroking all reported an en bloc sale by Libya's state run General National Maritime Transport. The company sold two 2002-built 112,000 dwt Aframax tankers, [EBN Batuta](#) and [Intisar](#), to Middle Eastern buyers for \$10.5m each.
