According to shipbroking sources, the company is now inviting offers for 2009 South Korean-built 74,900 dwt LR1 tankers *FPMC P Fortune* and *FPMC P Eagle*.

## Centrofin and Eastern Pacific take Formosa LR1 tankers

Less than a month after putting them on the market, Taiwan's Formosa Plastics has sold 2009 South Korean-built LR1 tankers *FPMC P Fortune* and *FPMC P Eagle*.

Both Seasure Shipbroking and Advance Shipping & Trading are reporting that Greece's Centrofin has paid \$16.1m for the *FPMC P Fortune*, while Idan Ofer's Eastern Pacific Shipping has bought the *FPMC P Eagle* for the same price.

VesselsValue puts the fair market value of the ships at a little over \$19m, however the lower price reflects an imminent survey required.
