ALPHALINER**Europe - Oceania service harmonised to 5,700-6,000 teu scale**

Hapag-Lloyd and CMA CGM are to complete the upsizing of their joint Europe - Indian Ocean - Australia pendulum service, branded as 'Europe Australia Express' (EAX) by Hapag-Lloyd and 'New NEMO' by CMA CGM from the 4,200 teu scale to the 5,700-6,000 teu size.

The last remaining classic panamax vessel replaced by a large container ship (LCS) was the 4,300 teu RIO CHARLESTON. Her slot was filled by the Hapag-Lloyd chartered 6,078 teu ships BRUSSELS.
