Bangladesh's Karnaphuli builds up boxship fleet at pace

Company orders four midsize containerships and snaps up secondhand quartet

Bangladesh's Karnaphuli Group — the parent of newly formed HR Lines — is wasting no time in building up the fleet of the country's only containership operator.

The Dhaka-based company is said to have struck a newbuilding deal with a Chinese state-owned shipyard for four 2,900-teu ships worth about \$152m.



Ms Chowdhury said HR Lines had purchased four more vessels from PIL since then, the 1996-built 1,550 teu *HR Aarai* (ex-Kota Wangsa) and *HR Farha* (ex-Kota Wangi) and the 1999-built 1,454 teu *HR Rhea* (ex-Kota Anggerik) and *HR Hera* (ex-Kota Arif).

The *HR Sahare*, *HR Sarera*, *HR Farha* and *HR Aarai* are deployed on HR Lines' Colombo-Chattogram Express service, while the *HR Rhea* and *HR Hera* are deployed on the Bangladesh Express Service, which calls at Chattogram, Singapore and Port Klang.
