Viken Shipping controlled suezmax tankers **KRONVIKEN** & **SOLVIKEN**- 152,385 tdw, built 1988/1989 Daewoo (Double sides/single bottom) are sold to clients of Tanker Pacific region USD 18.5/19 mill.

Norwegian owner Viken Shipping is renewing its tanker fleet and is said to have sold its two oldest units.

Sources say the double-sided, Daewoo-built, 152,000-dwt suezmaxes **SOLVIKEN** (built 1989) and **KRONVIKEN** (built 1988) have been sold to Sammy Ofer-controlled Tanker Pacific for between \$18m and \$19m each. Both ships have come off long-term charters to TotalFinaElf in the last year. The oil major extended the **SOLVIKEN** charter for a period earlier this year.
