**GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:**

Astilleros Fontec in Buenos Aires, Argentina, has finally delivered the **PU GLORY** (11,423-dwt, 800-TEU capacity combination ship) to Glory Shipping.

Sri Lankan interests ordered three such vessels from Astilleros Argentinos Rio de La Plata S.A. (ASTARSA), with the first two delivered after five years. The third ship experienced delays in outfitting, before ASTARSA was declared bankrupt.

Astilleros Fontec leased some of the yard and agreed to complete the **PU GLORY**, classed by RINA.
