GENERAL VESSEL INFORMATION:

Bulgarian cargo ship has rammed into a French fishing boat in dense fog on the edge of the Dover Strait. The captain of Bulgarian **PEYO YAVOROV** ship claimed he was unaware of the collision, regional newspaper La Voix du Nord says. The Bulgarian ship was held in the port of Havre and is expected to be released Friday. Both vessels sustained some damage but no casualties were reported.
