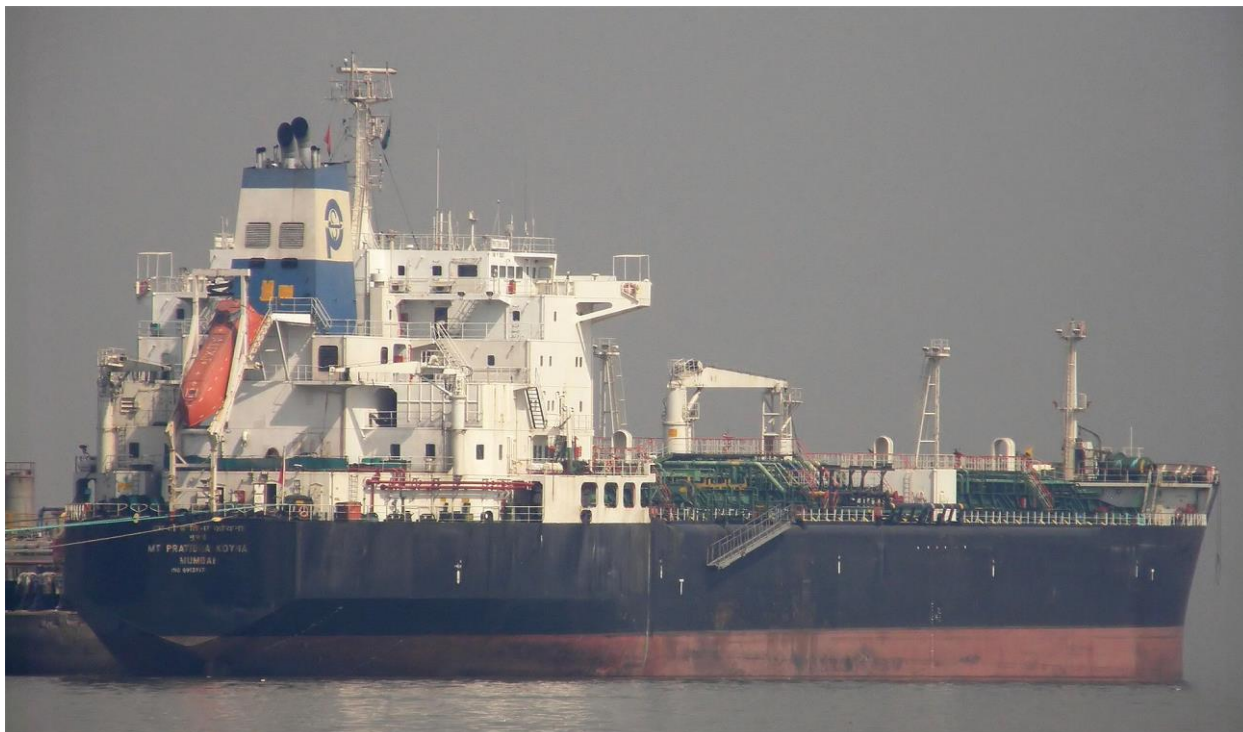

Pratibha Shipping to sell/scrap majority vessels: DGS

Private sector shipping company Pratibha Shipping, which has a fleet of nine oil tankers, is planning to either sell or scrap five vessels due to financial crunch, Directorate General of Shipping (DGS) said on Friday. The vessels, owned by the company, are presently in ports or at anchorage or at the shipyards in Indian waters and overseas, the DGS statement added.

A total of three vessels — **Koyna at a port in Bahrain**, and Chandrabhaga and Narmada in Chinese shipyards, are anchored in foreign shores, with owners having outstanding dues in both the geographies, the DGS said.

Mongolian oil tanker was banned from leaving Bahrain waters because it owed over \$220,000

According to a report in the **Gulf Daily News**, the Mongolian oil tanker was banned from leaving Bahrain waters because its Singapore-based managing company had not paid Bahrain's Asry shipyard and Kanoo Shipping more than \$220,000.

Asry took legal action against the shipping company and its Indian owner, and a Bahrain court in February ordered the vessel to be seized until the debts have been repaid.

Sixteen sailors have been left to their own devices for months after their vessel **MT Surya Kuber** got seized in Bahrain due to unpaid debts.

The crude oil tanker was banned by a court order in February from leaving the country as its Singapore-based owner 7Seas Ship Management failed to pay Arab Shipbuilding & Repair Yard (Asry) and Kanoo Shipping more than \$220,000, the Gulf News Daily reports.

The vessel came to Bahrain for repairs, but the ship owner failed to pay Asry for the services, prompting the shipbuilder to resort to legal action.
