Yang Ming has received the YM MOBILITY, first of four ships of 6,588 teu ordered by this owner at the China Shipbuilding Corp. (CSBC - Taiwan) in two steps in July and November 2007, with the deliveries subsequently deferred by six to twelve months due to the financial crisis. The YM MOBILITY is to join the new CKYH Asia-Med 2 loop (MD 2). She follows the YM MUTUALITY, delivered last month

Container explodes on Yang Ming ship in Ningbo

August 9, 2024

One of Yang Ming Marine Transport's ships suffered an explosion today (9 August) around 1.40 pm local time, while berthed in Ningbo, China.

Video footage taken by office workers in a nearby office building shows smoke billowing from the ship.

The Ningbo Maritime Search and Rescue Centre said the 6,589 TEU YM Mobility was berthed in Ningbo's Beilun terminal and was carrying hazardous goods.

None of the crew on the 2011-built YM Mobility and the port workers were injured, although office buildings near the port were hit by shockwaves from the blast. According to EconDB, YM Mobility is deployed to the China-Gulf Express (CGX) service that calls at Shanghai, Ningbo, Xiamen, Umm Qasr, Hamad and Jebel Ali. The service is run by Yang Ming, Ocean Network Express (ONE) and HMM.



Explosion at Ningbo Port Seen Impacting Supply Chains

The incident, which has led to the closure of one of the world's busiest container terminals, is expected to significantly impact global supply chains, especially on the main trade lanes out of Asia.

The incident took place on August 9 when a container loaded with hazardous materials [exploded](#) aboard the *YM Mobility* while it was berthed at Ningbo Beilun's Phase III Terminal. The explosion, which involved organic peroxide materials, has led to the closure of the terminal until further notice.

Yang Ming declares general average after YM Mobility fire at Ningbo Port

On 9 August 2024, a fire occurred near the bow of the *YM Mobility* at the Port of Ningbo. In response, Yang Ming declared General Average on 18 August 2024, to protect the common interests of the vessel, cargo owners, and all parties involved.
